No: 2519 /F 29/01/2016/13/2/ED: Whereas, the State Government is of the opinion that in the event of closure of industries operating in the State, such as All Steel Plants, Rolling Mills, Sponge Iron Plants, Rice/Dal Mill, Solvent Plant, Ferro Alloys, Iron ore Pellet Plant, Iron beneficiation Plant or combination thereof and other Small and Medium industries including all downstream and manufacturing units, Poultry Farm, Agriculture and Allied and other connections upto 20 MVA and such Mini Steel Plant and Ferro Alloys units having capacity upto 2 Million Ton Per Annum (MTPA) which are consuming electricity generated from its own captive power plants, due to recession in industrial/ financial sector, it may cause large scale unemployment of workers engaged in the industry and in view of adverse impact on the revenue of the State it is necessary and it is expedient in public interest to extend various concessions in electricity duty applicable for the period between 15th September, 2015 to 31st March, 2016 under Special Package from 1st April, 2016 to 31st March, 2017;

——And Whereas, it is necessary to increase the capacity of consumer in serial number 10 and 13 of Part-A of the Schedule of the Chhattisgarh Electricity Duty Act, 1949 (No. X of 1949), up to 20 MVA in place of 15,000 HP;

And Whereas, electricity duty on such Steel and Ferro Alloys industries of the State having capacity more than 2 MTPA and consuming electricity generated from its Captive Power Plant requires to be reduced from existing 15% to 12% for the period between 1st April, 2016-and 31st March, 2017;

And Whereas, such Generating Company, Captive Generating Plant and Producer of Private/ Public Sector of the State, which are not supplying power at Energy (Variable) charges to the state, it is necessary to levy 15% of Average Cost of Supply indicated in the applicable tariff order in place of electricity duty which is 15% of 'the tariff', for electricity for auxiliary consumption and their own consumption;

Generating Plant and Producer of Private/Public Sector of the State, which are supplying power at Energy (Variable) charges to the State, it is necessary to levy 10% of Average Cost of Supply in the tariff order from 1st April 2016 or date of commercial production, whichever is later, till 12 years and thereafter at the rate of Average Cost of Supply for time being in force in place of electricity duty which is 15% of 'the tariff', provided that in case on 31st March, 2016 payment of electricity duty along with interest is not due on these producers, for electricity for auxiliary consumption and their own consumption;

Now therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Section 3-B and Section 3-C of the Chhattisgarh Electricity Duty Act, 1949 (No. X of 1949), the State Government, hereby, makes the following further amendment in the Schedule of the said Act with immediate effect, namely:



- 5. After note 4 of the Schedule, the following shall be added, namely:-
 - *5. Interpretation of word "tariff" in serial number 21 and 22:- Electricity Duty payable for electricity consumed by Generating Company, Captive Generating Plant and producer of private/public sector of the State and for their auxiliary consumption and their own consumption, shall be commuted as per 15 percent of tariff for Start up Power indicated in the tariff order for time being in force, on the electricity received by them from Chhattisgarh State Power Distribution— Company Limited for commencement of generation or in the event of supply to be received.
 - 6. Eligibility for concession of private electricity producer: Such electricity producer of private sector included in serial number 22, on which amount of electricity duty on auxiliary consumption is due, then they shall have the facility of paying electricity duty of 10 percent of average cost of supply from 1st April 2016 or the Commercial Production, whichever is later, till 12 years and thereafter at the rate of the average cost of
