Re: Rating Letter for BLR & BONDS of Chhattisgarh State Power Distribution Company Limited

India Ratings and Research (Ind-Ra) has affirmed Chhattisgarh State Power Distribution Company Limited's (CSPDCL) instruments as follows:

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\$Ind-Ra has assigned an unsupported rating in compliance with the Securities and Exchange Board of India's circular dated 13 June 2019, which requires credit rating agencies to disclose unsupported ratings without factoring in the explicit credit enhancement (CE) and supported rating after factoring in the explicit CE.

In issuing and maintaining its ratings, India Ratings relies on factual information it receives from issuers and underwriters and from other sources India Ratings believes to be credible. India Ratings conducts a reasonable investigation of the factual information relied upon by it in accordance with its ratings methodology, and obtains reasonable verification of that information from independent sources, to the extent such sources are available for a given security.
